Clinical experience, during which students are supervised by practicing physical therapists, is both a key and required component of the MScPT program. Clinical internships provide the opportunity for students to put the theory and clinical skills learned during the in-class component of the curriculum to clinical practice.

University of Toronto Physical Therapy clinical education sites are located within the Greater Toronto Area and include Oakville in the west, Pickering in the east and Barrie in the most northern area of the catchment. Students must be prepared to go to any of our clinical facilities within this catchment to complete their clinical experience. Any costs incurred while traveling to clinical internships, and/or when out-of-town accommodations are required, are the sole responsibility of the student.
