OIEPB Clinical Internship 1: Musculoskeletal, Cardiorespiratory or Neurological PT Practice January 8 – February 2, 2024 (4 weeks)

The goals of this first clinical internship are to provide internationally educated physical therapists enrolled in the Ontario Internationally Educated Physical Therapy Bridging (OIEPB) program with opportunities to integrate theory into Canadian PT practice. In addition to their international PT training, learners will have completed the following Bridging courses: Physiotherapy Practice within the Canadian Health Care Context and Consolidating Physiotherapy Fundamentals in Canada. A comprehensive description of the program can be found at https://oiepb.utoronto.ca/. We require 12 internships for this session.

OIEPB Clinical Internship 2: Musculoskeletal, Cardiorespiratory or Neurological PT Practice March 25 – May 3, 2024 (6 weeks)

The goals of this final clinical internship are to provide internationally educated physical therapists enrolled in the Ontario Internationally Educated Physical Therapy Bridging (OIEPB) program with opportunities to further integrate theory into Canadian PT practice. In addition to their international PT training, learners will have completed the following Bridging courses: Physiotherapy Practice within the Canadian Health Care Context, Consolidating Physiotherapy Fundamentals in Canada, Clinical Internship 1, and Integrating Physiotherapy Practice in Canada. A comprehensive description of the program can be found at https://oiepb.utoronto.ca/. We require 12 internships for this session.

Internship 4: April 8 – May 17, 2024 (Class of 2024; 6 weeks)

This will be the students' fourth internship in the program. Up to this point, the students will have completed courses on Critical Foundations in Physical Therapy (4 weeks); Physical Therapy Practice 1 (12 weeks; musculoskeletal system focus); Physical Therapy Practice 2 (9 weeks, cardiorespiratory system focus), and Physical Therapy Practice 3 (11 weeks, neurological system focus); Advanced Clinical Thinking (6 weeks; with a complex multi-system focus); Scholarly Practice 1 (3 weeks, research focus); Physical Therapy Practice IV (12 weeks, advanced MSK). Internship offers for this session can be in any practice area. We require **109 internships** in this session.

Internship 5: July 22 - August 30, 2024 (Class of 2024; 6 weeks)

This will be the students' fifth and final internship in the program. Up to this point, the students will have completed courses on Critical Foundations in Physical Therapy (4 weeks); Physical Therapy Practice 1 (12 weeks; musculoskeletal system focus); Physical Therapy Practice 2 (9 weeks, cardiorespiratory system focus), and Physical Therapy Practice 3 (11 weeks, neurological system focus); Advanced Clinical Thinking (6 weeks; with a complex multi-system focus); Scholarly Practice 1 and II (3 weeks + 6 weeks, research focus); Physical Therapy Practice IV (12 weeks, advanced MSK); Selective (3 weeks). Internship offers for this session can be in any practice area. We require **109 internships** in this session.

Internship 1: June 3 – July 12, 2024 (Class of 2025; 6 weeks)

This will be the students' first full-time internship in the program (though they will have experienced 20 Active Clinical Exposure (ACE) half-days. Up to this point, the students will have completed courses on Critical Foundations in Physical Therapy (4 weeks); Physical Therapy Practice 1 (12 weeks; musculoskeletal system focus); Physical Therapy Practice 2 (9 weeks, cardiorespiratory system focus), and Physical Therapy Practice 3 (11 weeks, neurological system focus). Internship offers for this session can be in any practice area. We require **110 internships** in this session.

Internship 2 and 3 (Class of 2025; @ 6 weeks) September 30 – November 8, 2024 and November 11 – December 20, 2024

These will be the students' second and third internships in the program. Up to this point, students will have completed the following courses: Critical Foundations in Physical Therapy (4 weeks); Physical Therapy Practice 1 (12 weeks; musculoskeletal system focus); Physical Therapy Practice 2 (9 weeks, cardiorespiratory system focus), and Physical Therapy Practice 3 (11 weeks, neurological system focus); Advanced Clinical Thinking (5 weeks; with a complex multi-system focus); Scholarly Practice 1 (3 weeks, research focus). Internship offers for these sessions can be in any practice area including leadership, administration or research opportunities. We require **110 internships** in each of these sessions.
